HOUSE WAYS

The house will always play the same and will play the highest potential winner or push hand possible with the seven- (7) cards dealt to the dealer. The Supervisor will have the final say as to house hand dealt.

NO PAIR: Use the second and third highest cards for the low hand.

ONE PAIR: Always use in high hand.

TWO PAIR: A. Always split aces and any other pair | B. KEEP two pairs - 6's and below. | C. SPLIT two pairs - 7's and above. | D. TWO PAIRS: One pair 6's & below and one pair 7's & above. | 1. Without Ace - SPLIT. | 2. With Ace - KEEP - and use Ace in low hand.

THREE PAIRS: Always play the highest pair in low hand.

THREE OF A KIND: Always keep 3 of a kind in the high hand. EXCEPTION: 3 aces with no possibility for straight or flush keep 2 aces in high hand and 1 ace with next highest card to low hand.

TWO - THREE OF A KIND: Always play pair of the highest three of a kind as low hand.

PAI GOW HOUSE WAYS

STRAIGHTS/FLUSHES/STRAIGHT FLUSH/ & ROYAL

FLUSH: A. With a six (6) OR seven (7) card straight/flush, use the highest card in the low hand.

B. Any straight/flush with a pair that DOES NOT break up the straight/flush, use the pair the low hand.

C. Break a straight/flush with two pair 7's or better or with two pair and an Ace.

Two pair rules apply.

D. Break a straight/flush when having two pair and one of which are Aces (INCLUDING THE JOKER), exception will be if the 5-card high hand would be stronger than a pair of aces and the 2-card low hand is still a pair.

Example ace-joker-2-3-5-6-6, setting will be a pair of 6's in the low hand and ace-2-3-joker-5 in the 5-card hand for a straight. See example on the following page.

When choosing BET a straight and a flush, use the one that allows for the highest low hand.

E. Play a straight or flush over straight flush to improve low hand.

F. Play a straight or flush over royal flush to improve low hand.

G. All straights, flushes and straight flushes with a full house, use full house rule.

H. Three of a Kind does not break up any straight or flushes. See example on the last page of this SOP.

FULL HOUSE: Always split, placing pair in low hand, unless the low pair are 2's with an Ace-Face or better, then place the Ace-Face or better as the low hand.

Also, when having a full house with two pairs, use the highest pair for the low hand.

FOUR OF A KIND: A. Always KEEP 6's and below.

B. 7's through 10's SPLIT unless hand contains an Ace or better.

C. Jacks through Kings SPLIT unless the hand contains an Ace-Face or better or an extra pair unless they are 2's or 3's, then split the face cards.

D. Aces always SPLIT except with a pair of Kings

FIVE OF A KIND: Always SPLIT unless with a pair of Kings.
